Usage of the data model as defined in DS/INF 163-1. RFID-data model

Dear Leif

Recently we discussed the rate of implementation of DS/INF 163-1. RFID-data model. I have asked the participants in the Danish Standard S24 affiliated working group of the present and coming usage and implementation of den data model as defined in DS/INF 163-1. RFID-data model.

I have asked for implementation volume and the number of different countries, where implementation have taken place. I have told that the information given to me would be made anonymous.

Most of the participating companies have replied. Several of the answers in a way where a dissemination can hardly take place. This is a relatively new market area and companies are for natural reasons reluctant to give away information that could have influence on their market positions.

I am sure that a number of implementations have taken place in quite a few countries but I can give no exact figures. There is a turmoil of ongoing negotiation on sales and implementations on a short term basis and there are great expectations on the longer term exploitation. In all this the information below is all what I can find at this moment.
